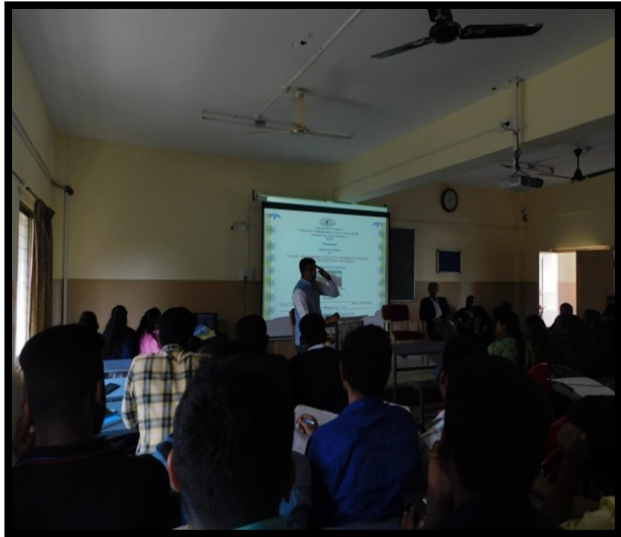
2. CELEBRATION OF BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF JUSTICE P.N BHAGAVATHI

Nataraju, Principal, JSS Law College was the resource person, he spoke on 'Judicial Activism'. Addressing the gathering he said the concept of judicial activism found its roots in the English concepts of 'equity' and 'natural rights'. The root of judicial activism in India is very difficult to find. For a very long time, the Indian judiciary had adopted an orthodox approach to the very concept of judicial activism



3. SPECIAL LECTURE

A Special Lecture on 'Scope and Importance of Fundamental Rights under Indian Constitution' was organized on 1st January 2022. Our college Alumni Dr. N Satish Gowda, Associate Professor University Law College, Bengaluru was the distinguished speaker in this occassion. He explained that the Fundamental rights are enshrined under Part III of the Indian Constitution and it was adopted on 26th November 1949 but was put on use on 26th January 1950. These Fundamental rights guarantee that every citizen of this nation can live a life of peace and harmony throughout the territory of India and these rights were included in the constitution because they were considered to be essential for the development of each and every individual. People of all races, religion, caste, or sex; have been given the right to move to the Supreme Court or the High Court for the enforcement of these rights. These Fundamental rights are divided into seven categories which are covered from Article 12 till Article 35 of the Indian Constitution.

5. CELEBRATION OF WORLD CONSUMER RIGHTS DAY

On 19th March 2022 at 10.30AM **World Consumer Rights Day** celebrated at Moot Court Hall. Our college alumni Sri Srinidhi H N, Member District Consumer Redressal Commission Chamarajanagara was the Chief Guest. Addressing the students he said celebrating the day is a chance to demand that the rights of all consumers are respected and protected, and to protest against market abuses and social injustices which undermine those rights. The actual plight of consumers of India can be declared as completely miserable. He pointed that, out of the various laws that have been enforced to protect the consumer rights in India, the most important is the Consumer Protection Amendment Act, 2019. According to this law, everybody, including individuals, a firm, a Hindu undivided family and a company, have the right to exercise their consumer rights for the purchase of goods and services made by them. It is significant that, as consumer, one knows the basic rights as well as about the courts and procedures that follow with the infringement of one's rights.
