

3. SPECIAL LECTURE

On 17th July, 2020 special lecture on RTI was organized online. Prof K.S Suresh, CEO, JSS Law College and also alumni of our college spoke of RTI. He mentioned that Right to Information is not included as a Fundamental Right in the Constitution of India, yet it protects the fundamental rights to Freedom of Expression and Speech under Article 19(1)(a) and Right to Life and Personal Liberty under Article 21 guaranteed by the Constitution. The authorities under RTI Act 2005 are called public authorities. The Public Information Officer (PIO) or the First Appellate Authority in the public authorities performs quasi-judicial function of deciding on the application and appeal respectively. This act was enacted in order to consolidate the fundamental right in the Indian constitution 'freedom of speech'. Since RTI is implicit in the Right to Freedom of Speech and Expression under Article 19 of the Indian Constitution, it is an implied fundamental right. All government agencies, whether they are under a state government or the Centre, come under the purview of the Act. 






4. SPECIAL LECTURE

He explained that the Fundamental rights are enshrined under Part III of the Indian Constitution and it was adopted on 26th November 1949 but was put on use on 26th January 1950. These Fundamental rights guarantee that every citizen of this nation can live a life of peace and harmony throughout the territory of India and these rights were included in the constitution because they were considered to be essential for the development of each and every individual. People of all races, religion, caste, or sex; have been given the right to move to the Supreme Court or the High Court for the enforcement of these rights. These Fundamental rights are divided into seven categories which are covered from Article 12 till Article 35 of the Indian Constitution.

6. CELEBRATION OF WORLD CONSUMER RIGHTS DAY

On 19th March 2022 at 10.30AM World Consumer Rights Day celebrated at Moot Court Hall. Our college alumni Sri Srinidhi H N, Member District Consumer Redressal Commission Chamarajanagara was the Chief Guest. Addressing the students he said celebrating the day is a chance to demand that the rights of all consumers are respected and protected, and to protest against market abuses and social injustices which undermine those rights. The actual plight of consumers of India can be declared as completely miserable. He pointed that, out of the various laws that have been enforced to protect the consumer rights in India, the most important is the Consumer Protection Amendment Act, 2019. According to this law, everybody, including individuals, a firm, a Hindu undivided family and a company, have the right to exercise their consumer rights for the purchase of goods and services made by them. It is significant that, as consumer, one knows the basic rights as well as about the courts and procedures that follow with the infringement of one's rights.

2. SPECIAL LECTURE

On 7th February 2023 at 10.30A M Special Lecture on Enforcement of Directive Principle of State Policy through Judiciary was organized. Dr. N. Satish Gowda Associate Professor University Law College, Bangalore University was the resource person. The resource person explained that, the Constitution is the fundamental law of the nation. An important feature of the constitution is the Directive Principles of State Policy incorporated in the Constitution. Although the Directive Principles are asserted to be "fundamental in the governance of the country," they are not legally enforceable. Instead, they are guidelines for creating a social order characterized by social, economic, and political justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity as enunciated in the constitution's preamble. Judiciary as being the protector and promoter of rights of the individual to perform the balancing act in an unbiased and fair manner has immense role to play in these days to interpret the directive principles as enforceable in order to establish welfare based society. The Directive Principles and state policies therefore offer the state an opportunity for use of the constitution as an instrument for change in definite social directions. The courts can even give directives to the state organs regarding what the state is required to achieve through legislative process.





3. SPECIAL LECTURE

O@23rd February 2023, a special lecture was on 'Law of Taxation' was organized. Sri. M C Sundara, Alumni of Vidyavardhaka Law College, Auditor and Consultant, Mysuru was the resource person. He explained about the Indian Tax Law system and majorly about the Income Tax Law in India.



4. FELICITATION TO NEWLY APPOINTED JUDGES, APP'S & INAGURATION OF LAW EXHITIBITON

On 11th March 2023 at 10.30AM a programme on Felicitation to Newly appointed Judge, APP's, Inaguration of Law Exhitibiton & relasing of Vikasa 2022 Magzine was organized. This programme inaugurated by Hon'ble Mr. Justice B.C. Shyam Prasad, Judge, High Court of Karnataka, Bengaluru. Chief Guest Sri Santhosh Gajannan Bhat, Additional Secretary-I, Law Deptarment, Vidhana Soudha, Bengalore and also alumni student of our college pointed out that, the prime object of legal education is to produce professional lawyers. The term 'professional lawyer' does not only cover the 'litigating, lawyer, viz.,' the lawyer who argues before the ordinary courts but all persons trained in law, whose employment is mainly dependent on their degrees in law Legal education should aim at furnishing skills and competence, the basic philosophies and ideologies for creation and maintenance of just society. It must sensitize society to identify its problems and ensure social and economic justice through rule of law and to eradicate injustice, poverty, corruption and nepotism from the society. The legal education stands for enhancement of human sensibility and injects a sense of protecting human liberty and equality before law. The curriculum of legal education should be thought of in terms of its objectives.
