



SCHOLARSHIP AWARENESS PROGRAMME

On 12th February 2021 at 2.00PM the scholarship awareness programme was organized by the SC/ST Cell at Room No 07. Sri H.S Shivakumara coordinator of SC/ST cell and E-attestation officer explained about the module of SSP scholarship details allowed for Pre-Matric Scholarship of Social Welfare, Backward Classes Welfare, Tribal Welfare and Minorities and to submit their applications online and also explained about the Scholarship offered by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India. This scholarship aims to provide financial support to talented students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Central OBC/minority communities/ General (Economically Weaker)/Kin of Defense Personnel (only technical education).







In this programmes the coordinator emphasized that the State Scholarships Portal is one-stop solution through which various services starting from student application, application

receipt, processing, sanction and disbursal of various scholarships to students are enabled. The initiative aims at providing a simplified, mission-oriented, accountable, responsive & transparent system called 'SMART' System for faster & effective disposal of scholarship applications and delivery of funds directly into beneficiaries account without any leakages. The State Scholarships Portal under the State e-Governance Plan aims at providing common electronic portal for implementing various Scholarships schemes launched by Union Government, State Government and Union Territories across the country. The SSP objective, benefits, eligibility documents and renewal procedures was mentioned and they are as follows:-

- Ensure timely disbursement of Scholarships to students
- Provide a common portal for various Scholarships schemes of Central and State Governments
- Create a transparent database of scholars
- Avoid duplication in processing
- Harmonization of different Scholarships schemes & norms
- Application of Direct Benefit Transfer
- All scholarships information available under one umbrella.
- Single integrated application for all scholarship.
- Improved transparency as system suggests the schemes for which a student is eligible.
- Duplicates can be reduced to the maximum extent



In this awareness programme Principal, Prof Deepu P explained about the documents which are required to be attested to the course and also mentioned that some of the documents should be kept ready before filling the online application under SSP. The documents are:

- Hostel Stay Certificate
- Fee Receipt
- Marks Card
- Study/ Bonafide Certificate
- Kin of Defense Personnel Certificate
- Parent's Income Certificate
- Student's SATS Identification Number
- Aadhaar Number or EID Number of Student and Parent
- Mobile Number
- Caste and Income Certificates.
- Bank Account Preferably in Nationalized Banks
- Bank Account Linked with Aadhaar Number
- NSP Scholarship ID
