The above programme was organized by IQAC, Vidyavardhaka Law College, Mysuru, on 10th October 2020, on the topic of “General Principles of Administrative Law: Issues and Challenges”. The chief guest and resource person was Prof. (Dr.) V. Sudesh, Professor of Law, former acting Vice-Chancellor, Dean Faculty of law, Chairman and Principal, University Law College, Bangalore University, Bengaluru. This programme was inaugurated by our principal Smt. Deepu. P and Sri Prashanth T M made welcome address. The resource person spoke about the general principals of Administrative law. Indeed he mentioned as Administrative law deals with- a) structure, powers & functions of organs of administration, b) limits of their powers, c) methods & procedures followed by them in exercising their powers and functions; & d) methods by which their powers are controlled including legal remedies available to person whose rights are infringed by their operation. He had explained about Principals of Rule of Law, Separation of Power (Separation of powers is the division of the powers and functions of government among the three separate arms of government, that is, the legislature, executive, and the judiciary), and Classification of administrative Actions with case laws. In his speech he had mentioned about the importance of Principals of Natural justice in the administrative adjudication (Concisely natural justice means: The inherent right of a person to a fair and just treatment in the hand of rulers, their agents and other persons.). This programme was witnessed by our Director, staffs, students, and many other participants. Finally the vote of thanks was made by our director Prof. K. B.Vasudeva.
