On 9th February 2024 Model State Legislative Assembly Competition was organized in association with KILPAR, Bengaluru. Addressing the gathering he said that students should cast their vote and elect their representatives. Nowadays bills are passed without being discussed on floor. The people's representatives are only wasting time by speaking unnecessary things in

Presently these universities are lacking fund and are running through the fees paid by the poor people. The bill should be passed by giving equal opportunity to ruling party and opposition party to speak and discuss on bill in detail.



In this occasion chief guest, K Dwarkanath, Director of KILPAR addressing the students said that KILPAR was established in 2005 and till date it is advising government to bring new laws and recently it has recommended to establish ethics committee unlike Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha. Democracy can survive only if representatives of the people work. He motivated the students to participate and cast their vote in elections.



President Sri Gundappagowda delivering the presidential speech appreciated the work of VVLC in organizing such programme. He said this kind of competitions gives political exposures to students. They will learn how to take up the matter for discussion in legislative assembly and how the people elected leaders play role in discussing the problems in a state.
