BRIEF REPORT OF SPECIAL LECTURE ON OPPORTUNITIES IN LEGAL PROFESSION

On 14th December 2023 special lecture on opportunities in legal profession was organized at Room No. 2 for first year LL.B students. Prof (Dr). Anil H. Havaldhar, Principal, R.L Law College, Belagum, was invited to deliver the lecture on “Opportunities in Legal Profession”. Delivering the lecture he spoke about legal professions, mechanism of law and its impact on the Society.

He gave brief introduction of law course as law is a Professional Course; Lawyers/Advocates are called as Social Engineer’s. In India, Bar Council has the authority to control over the Advocate Profession. According to him, they stated major THREE stages as that, *firstly*, beginning 5 years, it is only the work without any money, *secondly*, 10+ years, work with having money and *finally*, No work but only money.



He guided to learn law with the zeal but not by force as law is live and dynamic. It was suggested that Patience will be the key to be a better lawyer in this profession and stated that even the advocates will always remain as law student and they will read and learn until they die. Lawyers have elevated reputation in the society. The main elements to be a successful Advocate are Common Sense, Patience, Hard work, Discipline and Punctuality.

Further, he threw the light on the Supreme Court Landmark Judgment, Keshavananda Bharati case was

suggested to read and understand the provisions of law. It was suggested to read some of the judicial pronouncement and apply those decisions into the present scenario. “Lawyers are jack of all master of none”, by stating this he spoke about the comparative study of the Indian Constitution with the US Constitution. And finally guided the students to read the law of land to apply their thoughts to the legal field. The lecture was concluded with the vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Sridevi Krishna, Asst.
