





Brief Report on United Nations Conference 5th June 2024

International Virtual Model United Nations Conference was organized on 5th June 2024 in association with Institute of Legal and Policy Research. The programme began with the welcome note delivered by the coordinator Dr. Sridevi Krishna. This programme was inaugurated by Proof (Dr) T.R Maruthi, Director, School of Law, University of Mysore. Speaking in this occasion he said environment protection is a prime concern at universal level today. All countries have come forward to bring a universal principle on protection of environment where polluters may be an individual or a state should be held responsible for causing damage to the environment. He highlighted some of the instances where state responsibility was casted upon a State which violated the principles of environment protection.
