Report of Sadbhavana Diwas-2023

The IQAC and NSS unit of VVLC has organised **Sadbhavana Diwas-2023 Programme** on 21-08-2023 at Room No-9. Dr. Deepu. P., Principal introduced the speaker of the programme Dr. S.B. Boregowda, Assistant Professor of Law to students. Dr. Boregowda while addressing the students said, the birth anniversary of former Prime Minister late Rajiv Gandhi on 20 August of every year is observed as Sabhavana Diwas. The theme of Sadbhavana Diwas is to promote National Integration and communal harmony among people of all religions, people of all languages and regions. On august 20 special programme and events will be organised at national, state, and at local level like speeches rallies and cultural programmes. They said this day let us pledge to put aside our differences and let us work together towards the greater good, just as Rajiv Gandhi did during his time as prime minister.

This day remind us of the importance of communal harmony, and goodwill and also call to action for all Indian citizens to work towards a common goal of peace and prosperity for all. They said, Rajiv Gandhi was assassinated in Sri Perumbur, Tamil Nadu. The assassination was carried by a suicide bomber from the Liberation Tigers of Taamil Eelam (LTTE), a militant organosation seeking an independent tamil state in Sri Lanka. To honour the legacy of Sri Rajiv Gandhi, Sadbhavana Diwas was established in 1992 a year after his untimely death. During his administration they keen to embrace the change, they knew that education is the key to progress and development, they promote to stand up for what is right and to empower women and to serve the people. They said that, Sri Rajiv Gandhi believed that the public service was a noble cause and worked towards serving the people of India. Finally they administered the Sadnhavana Day Pledge to all students. The programme was meaningful and successful. Co-ordinator Dr. Kumara. N.J, and Sri Shivakumara.
