Report of International Democracy Day-2023

The IQAC and NSS unit of VVLC has organised **International Democracy Day-2023 Programme** on 15-09-2023 at Room No-4. Dr. Deepu. P., Principal has explained the importance of International Democracy Day. They said UNESCO celebrates International Day of Democracy every year and there is a demand inherent in the democratic ideal that we must uphold, in the words of our constitution, 'Dignity, equality, and Mutual Respect of human beings' are important. They said that, this year has meaningful theme that 'empowering the next generation' as the theme suggests, it highlights the pivotal role that young people play in advancing democracy and emphasizes the importance of including their voices in decisions that profoundly affect their world.

Prof. Vasudeva. K. B., Director of legal Studies, was also present and explained the significance of the International Democracy Day-2023. They said that, India is the largest democratic country in the world. It retained democratic form of government on the basis of constitutional system. The establishment of the Day of Democracy can be traced back to the Universal Declaration on Democracy, which was formally adopted on September 15, 1997, by the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU). The IPU is an international organisation that comprises national parliaments from various countries. Further they said that, democracy represents a system where a nation's citizens possess the authority to elect their leaders and actively engage in decision making processes that impact their lives. In an effort to promote and uphold these democratic principles on a global scale, the United Nations General Assembly established the International Day of Democracy in 2007. According to the United Nations International Day of Democracy serves as valuable occasion to assess the global status of democracy. The fundamental objective is to advocate for and maintain democracy as an essential human right and a pivotal element of effective governance and global peace. Finally, as for the directions of Government of Karnataka and Karnataka State Law University, Dr. Kumara.
