R. while addressing the addressed the students expressed that, Anti-Terrorism Day revolves around highlighting the instances of terrorism that create disturbance in the nation. It aims to help people consciously avoid participating in activities that may seem harmful to others or to the nation. Terrorism is an act which causes a negative impact on economy of nation. It’s a direct economic destruction of property and lives, creates markets uncertainty, loss of tourism. Terrorism is not only an international problem it is local as well as state level problem as well. Mainly there are two types of terrorism, domestic and international. Domestic terrorism is based and executed by our own citizens without the external support. On the other hand international terrorism is connected to support by foreign groups, foreign governments etc.,

They further informed that, several causes behind the acts of terrorism. Resistance to colonial rule, ethnic separation, internal political factors, supports for external factors, strong ideological and religious beliefs. This act is a form of asymmetric warfare in order to directly force a government to agree to their demands. Further, they said that criminal, psychic, war and political terrorism. Further, they said that, there are four P for anti-terrorism. Firstly, prevent the people becoming terrorists or prevent supporting of terrorism. Secondly, pursue the terrorists’ attacks happening. Thirdly, strengthen our protection against terrorist attacks. Fourthly, prepare to minimise the impact of terrorist attack. Hence awareness and education to members of society especially to youths is the need of an hour to curb such activities.
