**Felicitation to Newly appointed Judges, APP's & Inaguration of
Law Exhibiton**

On 11th March 2023 at 10.30AM a programme on Felicitation to Newly appointed Judge, APP's, Inaguration of Law Exhibiton & relasing of Vikasa 2022 Magzine was organized. This programme inaugurated by Hon'ble Mr. Justice B.C. Shyam Prasad, Judge, High Court of Karnataka, Bengaluru. In his inaugural address justice pointed out that, the universities have played a significant role in exploring the changes in legal education over the last decade. They engage in field of legal education and strive to improve the quality of legal education in India. On the other hand National Law Schools laid emphasis on specialized learning. Many institutions have conferred altogether with the lecture method of teaching and have instead opted more interactive and innovative methods of learning. Law schools in India have a proliferating culture of moot courts which has made legal education for more practical and behavioral than simply learning the letter of law. The significance on co-curricular activities like Seminars, Workshops etc. has now become indivisible part of the course. Internships during the period of study are now a mandatory requirement. On campus recruitments become a common feature of most of law schools hence the legal education in India is going through a very exciting phase. Though India has the largest population of lawyers in the world, there is need for eminent lawyers. The opportunities for bright law graduates are massive and the new generation law schools have a major role to improve the standards of legal education in India. Hence, the scenario of legal education is becoming more and more specialized as was envisioned by the well-wishers of the legal profession.



Chief Guest Sri Santhosh Gajannan Bhat, Additional Secretary-I, Law Department, Vidhana Soudha, Bengaluru pointed out that, the prime object of legal education is to produce professional lawyers. The term ‘professional lawyer’ does not only cover the ‘litigating, lawyer, viz.,’ the lawyer who argues before the ordinary courts but all persons trained in law, whose employment is mainly dependent on their degrees in law. Legal education should aim at furnishing skills and competence, the basic philosophies and ideologies for creation and maintenance of just society. It must sensitize society to identify its problems and ensure social and economic justice through rule of law and to eradicate injustice, poverty, corruption

and nepotism from the society. The legal education stands for enhancement of human sensibility and injects a sense of protecting human liberty and equality before law. The curriculum of legal education should be thought of in terms of its objectives

Sri. Gundappa Gowda, Hon'ble President, Vidyvardhaka Sangha ® rendered presidential address spoke that, the real challenge today is on the legal and legal profession because people see lawyers as more equal than themselves.
