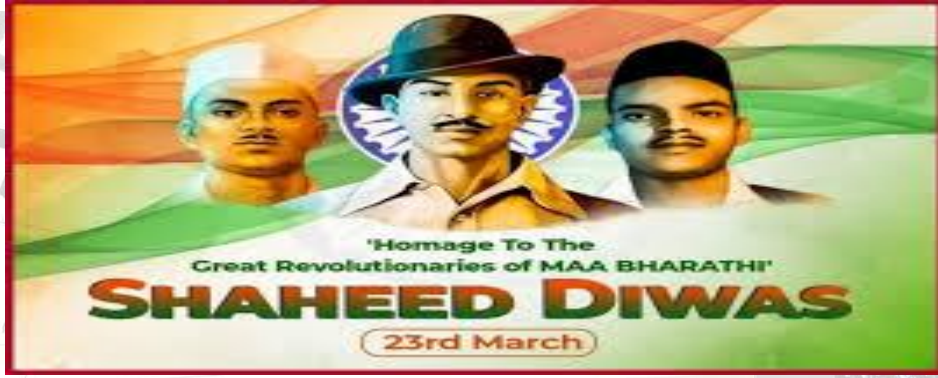

## BHAGATH SINGH 95<sup>TH</sup> MARTYRDOM DAY

Report

On the occasion of Bhagath Singh 95<sup>th</sup> Martyrdom Day on 8<sup>th</sup> April 2024 at 2pm, a special Lecture was organized by the college. In this programme **Sri. Sunil T R District President, AIDYO** was the chief Guest. In his address he pointed out the The 95th martyrdom day of Bhagat Singh was on March 23, 2025, marking the 95th anniversary of his execution on March 23, 1931, by the British colonial government. Along with his comrades Sukhdev Thapar and Shivaram Rajguru, he was executed for his role in revolutionary activities, and the day is observed annually as Shaheed Diwas (Martyrs' Day) in India to honor their sacrifice.

Martyr's Day or Shaheed Diwas , It is observed in India on several dates. March 23 is remembered as the day when three brave freedom fighters, namely Bhagat Singh, Shivaram Rajguru, and Sukhdev Thapar, were hanged by the British. Also, January 30th is observed as Martyr's Day or Shahid Diwas in the memory of Mahatma Gandhi. [Read here for more details.](#)



Bhagat Singh was born on September 28, 1907, in Lyallpur, Punjab. Bhagat Singh, together with his companions Rajguru, Sukhdev, Azad, and Gopal, fought for the assassination of Lala Lajpat Rai. Bhagat Singh became an inspiration for youngsters due to his daring adventures. He and his companions, on April 8th, 1929, threw bombs over the Central Legislative Assembly by reading the slogan "Inquillab Zindabad". And for this, a murder case was charged against them. On March 23rd, 1931, in the Lahore Jail, they were hanged. Their bodies were cremated on the banks of the Sutlej River.







This programme was presided by our Principal Dr. Deepu. In her presidential address she pointed out that, Shaheed Diwas, also known as Martyr's Day, is observed to remember the immense sacrifices made by patriots in the fight against British colonial rule. The day is observed to honor those who lost their lives for the independence of India. While January 30 is observed as Martyr's Day to mark the assassination of Mahatma Gandhi, March 23 holds a special place in India's history due to the martyrdom of Bhagat Singh, Rajguru, and Sukhdev. Martyr's Day or Shaheed Diwas is a significant day observed across India to honor the sacrifices of those who gave their lives for the country's independence. The day is marked on various dates throughout the year, but March 23 stands out as a special Shaheed Diwas to remember three brave freedom fighters Bhagat Singh, Rajguru, and Sukhdev who were hanged by the British on this date in 1931. This day serves as a reminder of their courage and the countless others who fought for India's freedom.
